

# BADGES OF THE ORDERS OF CALONTIR

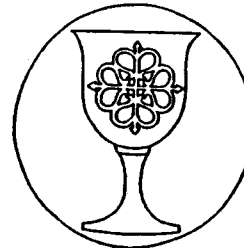
In the Kingdom of Calontir, we have a three-level award system, with the lowest being the AoA (Award of Arms) level awards. This is generally the first award individuals receive after getting their simple Award of Arms (if the individual did not receive a simple Award of Arms prior to receiving an AoA level award, the AoA level award also serves as an Award of Arms). The next step in the Calontir system is the GoA (Grant of Arms) level award, with the last step being a Peerage level award. Below is a brief description of the Orders of Calontir, with a description and picture of the Badge of each order.

When doing an original scroll for an individual, try to incorporate the badge of the award the individual is receiving into the layout of the scroll. When doing a scroll for a peerage level award, the scribe may choose to show the recipient's shield surrounded by the laurel wreath (for Laurels), a golden chain (for Knights), or a white baldric (for the Masters of Arms).

## ORDERS OF CALONTIR

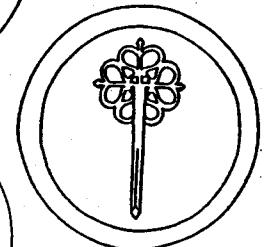
**Queen's Chalice**—Children's award for service.

Badge: *Purpure, a chalice or, charged with a cross of Calatrava purpure.* (Purple background, gold chalice with a purple Calatrava cross on it.)



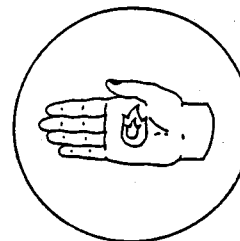

**Sword of Calontir**—Award for brave deeds done on the field or pertaining to warfare. Badge: *Cross of Calatrava, elongated in base so as to form a sword inverted, within a bordure argent.* (A Calontir Cross with the bottom point elongated to form a sword on a black background.)



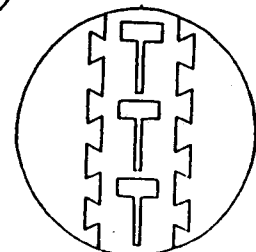
Sword of Calontir

**Keeper of the Flame**—Award for those who excel at creating a medieval feeling through their actions and appearance. Badge: *(Fieldless) Issuant from a dexter hand or, a flame, purpure.* (A purple flame coming out of a gold hand.)

**Leather Mallet**—AoA for skill in the sciences. Badge: *Purpure, on a pale dovetailed argent three leather mallets proper.* (Three brown mallets on white background, purple dovetail sides.)

**Boga-Fyrd**—AoA for skill in archery. Badge: *Sable, on a pile embattled between two longbows in pile argent a Cross of Calatrava purpure.* (Purple cross on white background, white bows on black background.)

**Iren-Fyrd**—AoA for skill in fighting. Badge: *Sable, on a pile embattled between two spears in pile argent a Cross of Calatrava purpure.* (Purple cross on white background, with white spears on black background.)

**Torse**—AoA for service. Badge: *A torse with mantling in alternating bands of purple and or.* (Gold and purple torse on a fieldless background.)

**Golden Calon Swan**—AoA for skill in the arts. Badge: *Purpure, a swan naiante or.* (Gold swan on purple background.)

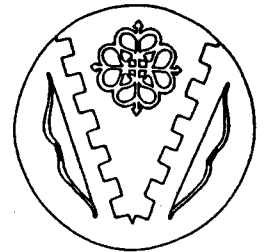
**Silver Hammer**—GoA for exceptional skill in the sciences. Badge: *Sable, a hammer argent.* (Silver hammer on a black background.)

**Boga-Hirth**—GoA for exceptional skill in archery. Badge: *Per chevron embattled sable and argent, in pale two strung bows in saltir argent and a Cross of Calatrava purpure.* (Purple cross on white background, white bows on a black background above.)

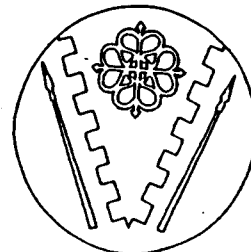
**Iren-Hirth**—GoA for exceptional skill in fighting. Badge: *Per chevron embattled sable and argent, two battleaxes in saltir argent and a Cross of Calatrava purpure.* (Purple cross on white background, white axes on a black background.)

**Cross of Calontir**—GoA for exceptional service. Badge: *Purpure, within a bordure or, the Cross of Calatrava or.* (Gold Calon Cross, purple background with a gold border.)

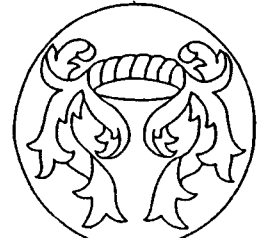
**Calon Lily**—GoA for exceptional skill in the arts. Badge: *Per pale purpure and Or, a fleur-de-lis within a bordure counterchanged.* (Counterchanged purple and gold lily.)



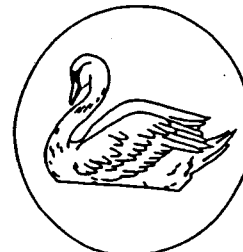

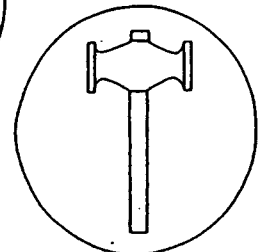

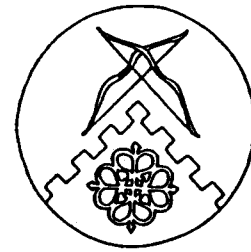
Torse



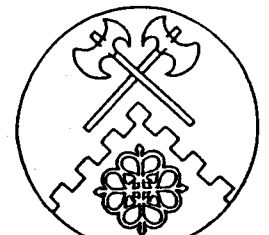
Golden Calon Swan



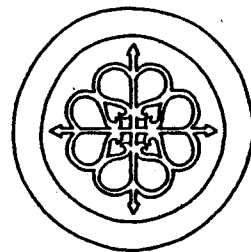
Silver Hammer



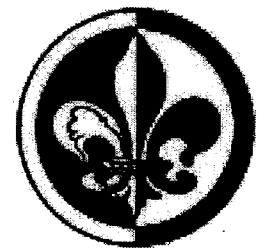
