

THE SCA CALENDAR

On scrolls, dates are used according to the SCA's calendar. This calendar reckons time from the first tournament, held on the first of May, 1966, of the Gregorian calendar.

In SCA reckoning, years are traditionally read as *Anno Societatis* (Latin for "year of the Society") followed by a number. In writing, the year usually appears as the initials A.S. followed by a roman numeral. For example, the day Calontir was made a Kingdom (February 18, 1984) is reckoned as the 18th day of February, A.S. XVIII.
